WHAT IS PSYCHOSTRUCTURAL BODYWORK?

IPSB's revolutionary approach to bodywork is founded in a few core concepts.

WE BELIEVE:

- informed, non-sexual touch is as primal and necessary for human survival as food. We view this work as a cornerstone of wellness, healthy touch lowers stress levels, improves sleep and healing capacity. Skin hunger and failure to thrive are human challenges that profoundly effect mental health at every stage of our lives.
- 2. expression of our emotional and mental (psychological) state.

 This means that some physical pain in the body is an expression of emotional pain. When connecting intentionally with the physical body, we can support all healing aspects with and for our clients.

- Releasing trauma should not create new trauma in the body.

 Our approach to bodywork is to treat it as a conversation with our clients' tissue in which the goal is "delicious discomfort" even in its deepest experience. The result is freedom of movement, not pain.
- Practitioners, witness and support but are not the source of.

 We are honored to support our clients life long journey in all stages and states of health. We hold space for our clients being empowered in their journeys with their bodies and we are honored to bear witness to help facilitate their process with them.

THE FOUR TENETS OF IPSB PHILOSOPHY



BODY

All bodies are good bodies and this work is meant for everyone.

We do not believe in healing trauma by creating more trauma in the body. This means our approach is consent-focused, and a substantial part of what IPSB emphasizes in its training is how to approach collaborative bodywork with healthy boundaries and respect.



MIND

We know that learning is most robust when integrating as many senses as possible.

Because of this, we incorporate movement, laughter, play, and sensory experiences as often as possible. We revisit and layer information over the course of the program, giving people with different learning styles ample opportunity to master anything they may find challenging.



HEART

For us, touching the body touches the soul.

A heart-centered practice is focused on being present first with ourselves and where we are in the moment. This means that we need to learn about healthy boundaries, how to communicate from a place of neutrality, how to mirror back what we are hearing

in order to ensure we understand what is being shared, and how to care for ourselves, so that we are resourced enough to show up for others.



Shared resources and connection, in a diverse and inclusive space, are why so many wonderful people have been drawn to IPSB over the years.

Mentorship, volunteer events, and community gatherings at IPSB help support the health of our community by supporting practitioners throughout their lives. Tutoring, professional development, personal enrichment, and community events are among the many resources we offer to all alumni and their families.


